

—MESSAGE FROM FATHER TIM—



I would be willing to bet that every parent who has ever brought a child to Mass has had the experience of hearing the question: "Why do we have to go to Church?" There are, of course, a lot of things that could be said in answer to this question. But, I

would like to offer an answer that I believe is suggested by the readings that we have this weekend. That is, one of the reasons for us to come to Church is to *pray* together, to *give thanks* together, to *ask for help* together and simply to *be* together.

"Why all of this "togetherness?" The answer is that we need this "togetherness." We need it very much. After all, the more that we – as individuals – are "together" as a family, community, and parish, the more we will be connected to God and to one another. And, the greater our understanding of these connections, the more we nurture this connectedness, and the more fulfilled, happy, healthy, and holy we will be. The less we understand our need to be connected to God and one another, the less we nurture this connectedness, the less happy, fulfilled, healthy, and holy we will be.

I am sure that all of you know who Ann Landers was because for many years, she wrote a very popular daily newspaper column in which she advised people with personal problems and concerns. Some years ago, she was being interviewed. In the middle of the interview, she was asked, "What is the question that you are asked most frequently by your readers?" Without skipping a beat, she answered: "The question most asked, by far, is, "What is the matter with me? Why am I so lonely?"

I know that it won't come as a complete surprise to very many of us that many people in this world of ours suffer from loneliness. And what is loneliness but the belief that we are *not* connected; we are *not* connected to one another, or God. For some, this feeling of loneliness and *dis-connectedness* is brief and goes away after a while; but for others, it can go on for a very long time.

What can we do about any of this? Regarding our own loneliness, we can do things that nurture our connectedness to God and others. Regarding the loneliness of others, we can be more sensitive and responsive to their needs. And, perhaps, even more to the point, we must come to see an important part of how it is that we must live as Christians.

One day, in California, a guide was taking a group of tourists through a stand of Sequoia trees. The guide was telling the visitors that though the trees were very old and very tall, their roots were surprisingly shallow and only went a few feet into the earth. On hearing this, a member of the group spoke out. "Wait a minute. I'm from Connecticut. and I know that trees this tall couldn't possibly survive if their roots were shallow. If that were the case, the first strong wind that came along would blow them right over." The guide answered: "Not Sequoia trees. They grow only in groves and their roots – though shallow - inter-twine under the surface of the earth. When a strong wind comes along, they hold each other up."

My friends: People, families, communities, and parishes must be Sequoia trees. We must be connected to God and one another so that when the strong winds of life blow, we will stand together and hold one another up. And when we stand together – connected to God and one another – we will begin to understand what Jesus is saying in His prayer to the Father that is contained in this weekend's Gospel. It is a prayer for us.


